



RICHARD P. RUBINSTEIN TO PRESENT
"MARTIN" AND "CREEPSHOW"
AT 41ST KARLOVY VARY INTERNATIONAL
FILM FESTIVAL

Producer Richard P. Rubinstein has accepted the invitation to attend this year's 41st Karlovy Vary International Film Festival (June 30, 2006 - July 8, 2006). Rubinstein will present the screenings of "George A. Romero's Martin" and "Creepshow," which he produced in 1977 and 1982 respectively. "Martin" was Rubinstein's first feature film and only one of the many films produced during his 12-year partnership with Romero. Rubinstein will also participate in the Midnight Screenings Panel on July 6th.

The KVIFF is the most important international film festival in central and Eastern Europe and is one of the oldest film festivals of all time (the first year took place in 1946).
